

## **Comets & shooting stars**

### **Student Worksheet ...**

- What is a meteor, or shooting star?
- What kind of frozen material makes up the center of a comet? How big is it?
- The comet (“like a ghost”) that we see in the sky is not a solid object. What is it?
- Which way does the “tail” of a comet blow?

### **Something else to think about...**

There’s a cosmic connection between comets and meteors. Almost all meteors are little pieces of a comet’s tail that got left behind. When the orbit of the Earth passes through one of these dusty trails, we see shooting stars. Sometimes there are so many it’s called a “meteor shower.”
