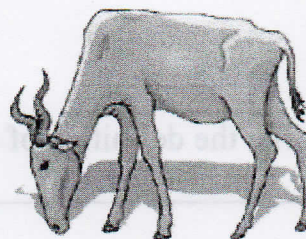


Animal Feeding Strategies

Many English words come from Latin. *Vorare* is a Latin word meaning *to eat* or *to devour*. So English words that end in *vore* mean *eater*. *Herbivore*, *carnivore*, *omnivore*, and *insectivore* are four words that end in *vore*.

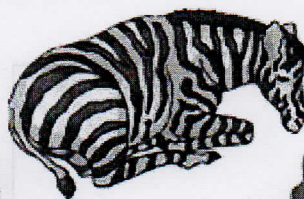
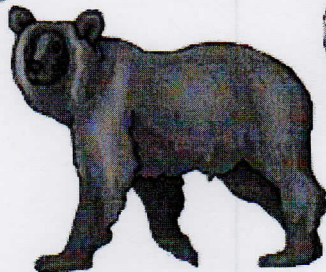
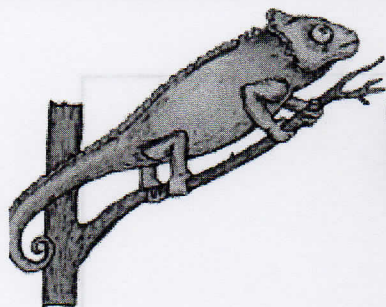
What is an omnivore? Hint: *Omni* is Latin for all or everything.




